

## Weekly reflection for the week of April 6

### Steadfast Love in Every Season

*“This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.”*

*“The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid.”*

*“His steadfast love endures forever.”*

Psalm 118 is a psalm for people who have been through something. It’s not written from a mountaintop of ease but from the other side of trouble. It’s the voice of someone who has felt pressure, fear, and uncertainty—and discovered that God’s love held firm through it all.

This makes it a perfect psalm for real life, where joy and hardship often sit side by side.

### God’s Love Outlasts Every Battle

The psalm begins and ends with the same declaration:

**“His steadfast love endures forever.”**

Not just when life is smooth.

Not just when prayers are answered quickly.

Not just when we feel strong.

God’s love endures—through fear, through waiting, through confusion, through victories and setbacks. The psalmist repeats this truth because we often forget it. Gratitude becomes an anchor when circumstances shift.
